Things to Remember (pdf attachment)

PRIOR TO YOUR SURGERY, PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE:

	Reviewed the essential cataract information, the educational video, and cataract consent documents carefully Understood the testing and lens options available to you and how they will impact your dependence on glasses after surgery Completed your hospital package including pre-surgery questionnaire Purchased the eye drops you will need before and after surgery Arranged for someone to accompany you to surgery and stay with you for 24 hours afterwards
ON THE DAY OF YOUR SURGERY BE SURE TO:	
	Wear loose fitting clothes
	Do not eat or drink anything except clear fluids (ie water, tea or coffee without milk/cream) on the morning of surgery
	Take your medications with a sip of water on the morning of surgery (except diabetes medications)
	Bring your completed package to the hospital
	Arrive on time (as indicated on your package)
	Bring a driver who is prepared to wait or return after 3 hours
AFTER	YOUR SURGERY BE PREPARED TO:
	Take eye drops as directed for 1 month
	Attend a follow-up appointment by phone within 24 hours and in-person within 2 weeks
	Avoid travel for the first 5 days
	Avoid swimming, rubbing the eye and strenuous activity for 2 weeks
	Update your glasses 1 month after surgery
